

Cumberland County Utilities Authority Monetization Q&A #2

1. Will CCUA consider an extension to the July 16, 2021, submission of the RFP response? **Yes**
2. Is the CCUA interested in only operation and maintenance partnership? **No**
3. Is CCUA authorized to sell if that is a likely outcome? **No** If so, is there a referendum requirement? **Not applicable**
4. What is the review period expected? **Undetermined at this time.**
5. What is the decision process for the award of RFQ entity? **Please see the N.J. statutory authority.**
6. Is the intention of the Request For Qualifications to identify a consultant to evaluate and recommend general monetization solutions available to the Cumberland County Utilities Authority (“Authority”), including a concession, lease, long-term contract, sale, etc.? **YES**
7. If pursued by the Authority, would the recommended monetization solutions(s) proceed under a separate bidding process in accordance with the appropriate procurement statutes? **If pursued, the process would follow the appropriate legal process.**
8. Would the successful respondent to this procurement be excluded from participating in a future procurement for concession, lease, long-term contract operations and maintenance, sale, etc. that would proceed under the appropriate procurement statutes? **No. The successful respondent would be eligible to obtain the concession agreement.**
